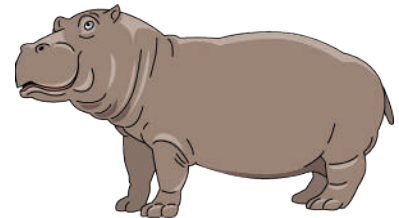
Animals found in the forest are called **wild animals**. For example,

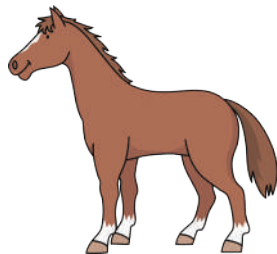
Wild Animals

Whales and turtles use their **flippers** to swim.



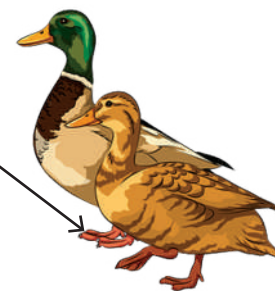

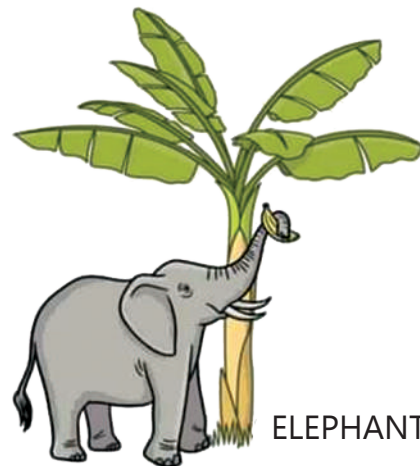
Different animals eat different kinds of food.
