Our Neighbourhood

The house, streets, shops around our house make up neighbourhood. You see some important places in our neighbourhood, like a school. Let's read about those places.



1. A School

A school is a place where children go to and learn things. They learn to read and write. Teachers teach the children.

2. A Hospital

Sick people go to the hospital to get medicines. The take the medicines and get well.

Doctors and nurses work at a hospital.



3. The Police station

We see policemen and policewomen at a police station.

They keep the people in the area safe. They catch thieves.

4. The Fire station

We see a fire engine and some firemen at a fire station. They come and put out any fire in the neighbourhood. They protect our houses from fires.



5. The Market

The market is a place where we buy things. We see different shops at a market.

6. The Post office

The post office is a place where we post our letters.

We buy stamps and postcards there.

We can save our money in a post office.



7. The Bank

A bank is a place where poor people get their pensions.

A bank gives farmers money to grow crops.

People keep their jewels in a bank.

8. A Library

A library is a place where people read newspapers and books.

People can take a book home to read during holidays.



9. Places of Prayer

People go to different place to pray to God.

Some people go to a Temple.

Some people go to Churches.

Some people go to Mosques.

Banks give you a card. It's called the ATM card. You can get your money at the ATM centre. Ask your parents about that card. Learn about it.

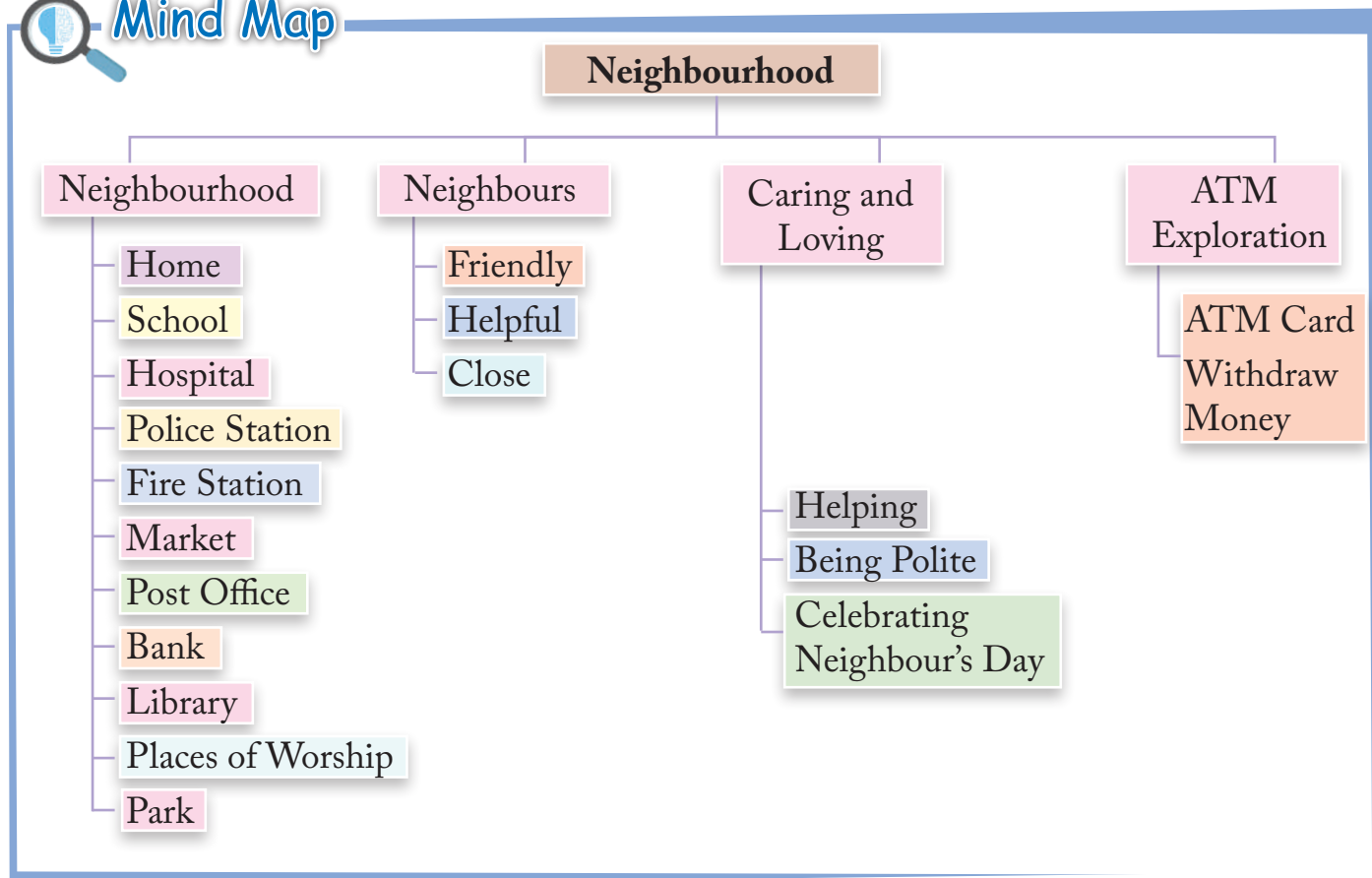

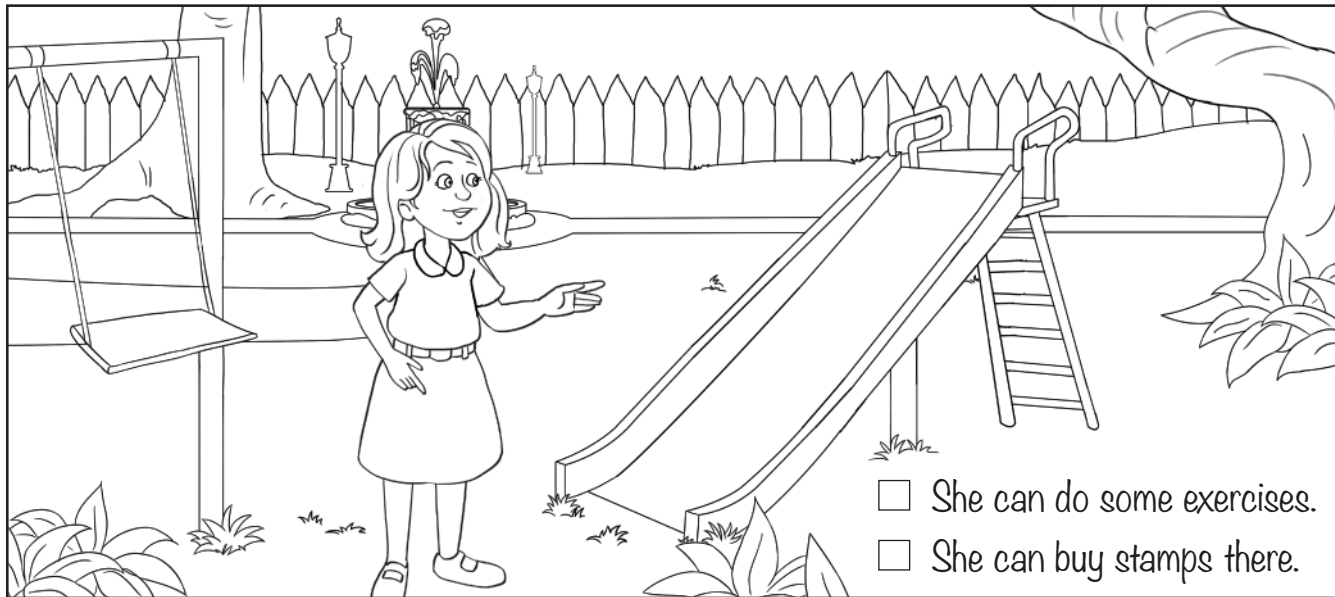
